GETTING TO POROS ISLAND

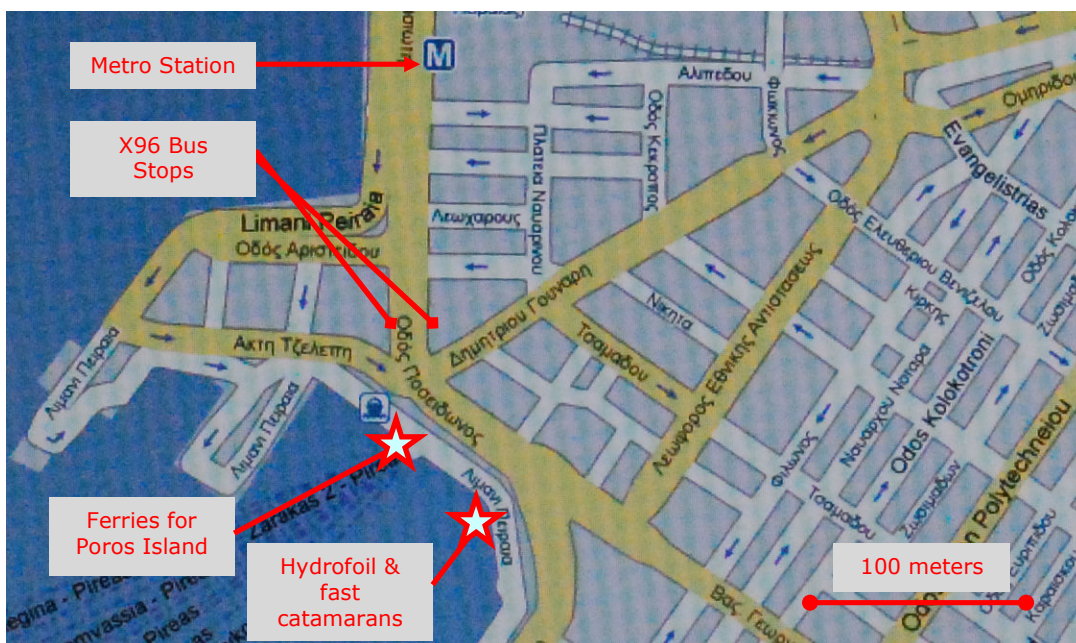
When traveling to Poros Island the most convenient airport is at Athens. From the UK, British Airways (www.ba.com), Olympic Air (www.olympicair.com), Aegean Airlines (www.aegeanair.com) and Easyjet (www.easyjet.com), amongst others, fly to Athens.

From the airport you must travel to the port at Piraeus. Taxis and trains are available; however the X96 bus runs from the airport straight to the port. Details can be found on the airport web site (www.aia.gr).

Finally, to get to Poros Island itself we suggest you take the Hellenic Seaways hydrofoil/fast catamaran/ferry from Piraeus (www.hellenicseaways.gr). You can book tickets on-line, which we recommend.

PIRAEUS

The port of Piraeus handles shipping travelling all over the Greek islands, and is therefore somewhat large and busy. This map shows the key features:



When travelling independently you should buy or pick up your hydrofoil, fast catamaran or ferry tickets from a Hellenic Seaways kiosk, look for their signs:



HOTELS
